

# *The Fundamentals of Christianity*



Join us each Wednesday evening at 7:00 in the Parish Library for a discussion of the essential doctrines of Christianity.

What is the nature of faith, and why is it different from other kinds of belief or trust? What does Christianity teach about the relation of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, and about their respective roles in salvation history? What must one do to be saved? The Rev'd Canon Macdonald-Radcliff will lead parishioners through these central questions and others like it during the course of our eight week intensive course. We will learn how Christianity (and Anglican Christianity in particular) has answered these questions in light of the holy scriptures and the councils of the early church. Our resource to help navigate this interesting terrain will be the Anglican priest and Oxford professor, the Rev'd Dr Alister McGrath, in his engaging and easily digestible volume, *Theology. The Basics*. (Copies will be made available through the Parish Bookstore.)
